



**SLIA Liability Insurance Assessment
Due: June 15, 2026**

Details of Assessment

The liability insurance assessment is set by the Benchers at Convocation based on an independent actuarial report and the recommendation of the Insurance Committee. The actuarial report estimates a base assessment that is intended to cover all costs for the upcoming insurance year. For 2026-2027 the base assessment is \$2,330. The Benchers approved a total assessment of \$1,546 per lawyer based on an assessment of \$1,454 per lawyer for the liability coverage plus \$92 for the mandatory CLIA cyber coverage. The assessments for the liability insurance has remained the same as the last policy period. SLIA has sufficient surplus to subsidize the assessment by \$876 per lawyer.

The assessment for the 2026-2027 policy year is set out below.
